

Breeches Size Chart

Breeches are sized in inches according to waist size.

Breeches In-Seam Length – breeches can be available in regular or long which refers to the in-seam length. Long is preferable for riders who are 5'7" or taller. Breeches do stretch but they do so vertically which gives you some maneuverability in length but since they do not stretch horizontally, small sizes can be pretty snug.

Seat Styles – Full seat breeches are synonymous with event and dressage riding. They are notable for the contrasting and gripping fabrics from the knee to the inner thigh. The full seat style is chosen because, the gripping fabric creates an almost sticky seat which helps them stay in the saddle as they perform their gaits.

³/₄ Seat or Extended Knee Patch breeches are typically worn by hunter and jumper riders, these breeches use the same contrasting materials as full seat breeches but the gripping fabric is only on the knee area.

Eventing – Riders wear white or light-coloured breeches

Hunter Classes – Beige, khaki, grey and other earthy tones are worn.

Jumper Classes – White is the most popular colour.

Dressage – There is no specified colour but white and light colours are common.

Clinics – It is advisable to wear light coloured breeches.
